### ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Selection of students is made by the selection committee. Those interested in admission to the programmes offered by the NICMAR University, Pune may apply online, pay fees and upload documents through our website or direct link: <https://admission.nicmar.ac.in> / <https://admission1.nicmar.ac.in>. All specified documents must be submitted. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Candidates' preference of programme will be considered, but the allotment will be done at the sole discretion of the admission department, NICMAR University. Candidates should appear for the selection procedure on the given dates.

### ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR PG PROGRAMMES

Applications are scrutinised and eligibility is established on the basis of the documents submitted. Eligible candidates will be invited to appear for the selection procedure, which comprises Post Graduate NICMAR Common Admission Test (PG-NCAT), Group Discussion (GD), Personal Interview (PI) and Rating of Application (RA).

Admission process will be conducted online. Information about the test centres will be shared later on.

**Scores of the aspirants appearing for Common Admission Test (CAT) / Management Aptitude Test (MAT) may be considered as an alternative for PG-NCAT. For candidates appearing in multiple written tests, the best performance will be considered.**

The RA is calculated on the basis of weighted scores of the cumulative academic performance along with work experience (wherever applicable) obtained from the documents submitted to NICMAR University by the candidates.

Selection of candidates is done on the basis of merit. The merit list is drawn on the basis of academic performance. Admission offer letters are issued in the order of merit.

## **ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR UG PROGRAMMES**

Applications are scrutinised and eligibility is established on the basis of the documents submitted. Eligible candidates will be invited to appear for the selection procedure, which comprises Under Graduate NICMAR Common Admission Test (UG-NCAT) and Personal Interview (PI). The details are as follows:

Under Graduate NICMAR Common Admission Test (UG-NCAT) will be conducted online. Shortlisted candidates will be called for Personal Interview (PI). PI would also be conducted online. Candidates can attend online UG-NCAT and PI from their residence or any suitable place as per their convenience.

## **ADMISSION UNDER MANAGEMENT QUOTA**

The NICMAR University has the policy of admitting a limited number of students under the management quota, not exceeding 5% of the total students admitted.

Candidates to be considered for admission under the management quota must fulfil the following requirements:

1. Satisfy all the eligibility criteria for admission to the respective full time programmes of the NICMAR University as mentioned on the website.
2. Must have appeared for the admission process of the NICMAR University as mentioned above.
3. All students who successfully complete the programme under this quota will also be eligible for on campus placement assistance both for internship as well as final Job placement (as applicable).
