A misty hillside retreat offering a breezy getaway from the city rush.



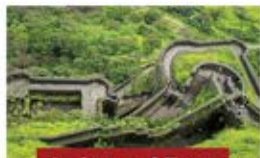
Lavasa

A cool hill station known for strawberry trails and lush forest viewpoints.



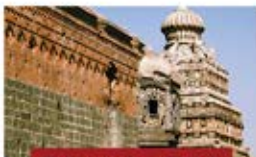
Panchgani
