Innerve 2025 Festival Report







Presentation on Construction Work Activities



This essential session featured Ms. Rohini Naidu, the Founder & CEO of The Girl Foundation, India, as the distinguished speaker. Ms. Naidu, known for her advocacy and work in promoting gender equality and fostering safe environments, brought invaluable insights into the legal and ethical dimensions of workplace conduct and redressal mechanisms. The seminar underscored the institutional commitment to creating a secure and equitable space for all members of the university community.



The core of the seminar revolved around educating the attendees on the Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) and the provisions of the Prevention of Sexual Harassment (POSH) Act of 2013.
