ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Selection of students is made by the selection committee. Those interested in admission to the programmes offered by the NICMAR University, Pune may apply online, pay fees and upload documents through our website or direct link: <https://admission.nicmar.ac.in> / <https://admission1.nicmar.ac.in>. All specified documents must be submitted. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Candidates' preference of programme will be considered, but the allotment will be done at the sole discretion of the admission department, NICMAR University. Candidates should appear for the selection procedure on the given dates.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR PG PROGRAMMES

Applications are scrutinised and eligibility is established on the basis of the documents submitted. Eligible candidates will be invited to appear for the selection procedure, which comprises Post Graduate NICMAR Common Admission Test (PG-NCAT), Group Discussion (GD), Personal Interview (PI) and Rating of Application (RA).

Admission process will be conducted online. Candidates can appear for the online PG-NCAT, GD and PI from their residence or any suitable place as per their convenience.

Scores of the aspirants appearing for Common Admission Test (CAT) / Management Aptitude Test (MAT) / AIMS Test for Management Admissions (ATMA) / Common University Entrance Test (CUET) PG 2023 will be considered as an alternative for PG-NCAT.

For candidates appearing in NCAT & other additional entrance exams (as mentioned above), the highest score among such exams will be considered for final merit.

The RA is calculated on the basis of weighted scores of the cumulative academic performance along with work experience (wherever applicable) obtained from the documents submitted to NICMAR University by the candidates.

Selection of candidates is done on the basis of merit. Admission offer letters are issued in the order of merit.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR UG PROGRAMMES

BBA/BBA (Hons.)/I-MBA and B.Tech. (Civil)

Applications are scrutinised and eligibility is established on the basis of the documents submitted. Eligible candidates will be invited to appear for the selection procedure, which comprises Under Graduate NICMAR Common Admission Test (UG-NCAT) and Personal Interview (PI). The details are as follows:

Admission process will be conducted online. Candidates can appear for the online UG-NCAT and PI from their residence or any suitable place as per their convenience.

Scores of the aspirants appearing for Under Graduate Aptitude Test (UGAT) / Integrated Program in Management Aptitude Test (IPMAT) - 2023 (IIM Indore) / Common University Entrance Test (CUET) UG 2023 will be considered as an alternative for UG-NCAT (for I-MBA programme).

For candidates appearing in NCAT & other additional entrance exam (as mentioned above), the highest score between these exams will be considered for final merit.

For B.Tech. in Civil Engineering programme candidates should appear in JEE/ MH CET/ PERA/CUET/Other states CET/CUET UG/UG-NCAT.

Selection of candidates is done on the basis of merit. Admission offer letters are issued in the order of merit.

Bachelor of Architecture (B.Arch.)

Applications are scrutinised and eligibility is established on the basis of the documents submitted. Eligible candidates will be invited to appear for the selection procedure, which includes Personal Interview (PI).

Admission process will be conducted online. Candidates can appear for the online PI from their residence or any suitable place as per their convenience.

The admission will be based on the candidate's NATA score (50% weightage) and marks of 10+2 examination or 10+3 Diploma examination (50% weightage).

DOMICILE

Out of the total approved intake capacity, forty percent of the seats are reserved for the students having domiciled in the State of Maharashtra.

ADMISSION DEFERMENT:

1. Eligibility for Admission Deferment:

Only those candidates who have paid the 1st installment of fee can apply for admission deferment before commencement of 1st year of the programme.

The candidate has to submit an application for 'admission deferment' in admission department before commencement of that programme stating the reasons for admission deferment. Admission deferment can be approved only for one year.

Who can apply:

- Serious medical illness.
- Serious family related reasons.
- Candidate not able to organize funds.
- Candidate's work related commitments, overseas assignments (over 6 months)

2. The application needs to be submitted to admission department, along with all the supporting documents for 'Admission Deferment' consideration.

3. An applicant who fails to obtain confirmation from Admission office of his/her deferment of admission will be deemed to have forfeited his/her position and will be deregistered from the course admitted to.

4. Process for Admission deferment:

- Deferred admission may only be granted to first year students who have paid the required 1st installment of fees.
- The admission department will scrutinize all the applications and forward it with comments to concerned authorities for approval. The request to defer the offer of admission will be reviewed on case to case basis and will be granted depending on the reason stated alongwith the supporting documents. NICMAR's decision with respect to this will be final and will not be challenged.
- Offer of admission deferment, if not, taken in the subsequent year will lapse and the fee paid will not be refunded. Further, the applicant, if still wants to apply to NICMAR, has to undergo the admission process again as a fresh applicant.
- The letter of deferment of admission will be issued by admission department to the applicant.

- Students who are found to have applied to other colleges and institutes during their time away from NICMAR will have their admission revoked and fees will not be refunded.
- Financial aid i.e. scholarship and award offers cannot be deferred. In case of admission deferment, the offered scholarships and awards will be forfeited.
- Once the programme has commenced, then even though the applicant may have not attended the classes, still he/she will not be 'eligible' for 'admission deferment'.

5. Payment of fees for re-admission in case of admission Deferment:

In case of admission deferment, student will have to pay 10% of total annual fees as readmission fee prevalent that year before commencement of the programme.
